



American Green Tree Frog

Equipment and housing

- **Housing:** We recommend a glass terrarium 30" x 30" x 45" . This size of enclosure will house your frog for its whole life. Tree frogs can be housed together providing they are of similar size, properly fed and have a large enough enclosure. Heat source should always be controlled using a thermostat.
- **Heating & Lighting:** These frogs require a temperature range from 22c-26c with a basking area of 27c-30c. They will benefit from a low output UVB for forest dwelling amphibians.
- **Substrate:** Substrate such as coir and moss can be used as bedding, live plants will also help with humidity, provide hides and basking areas.
- **Water:** Fresh conditioned water should always be available to the animal. You should also mist your enclosure regularly. Preferably 2/3 times per day. You can also install misting systems if you prefer.

- Decoration and hides: These additions are a must for frogs. The more plants and décor in the enclosure the better. They need plenty of basking areas and like to climb.

FOOD

Tree Frogs eat a variety of insects. These should be fed the appropriate size insect on a daily basis. Feeders should not be left in the enclosure uneaten. Frogs are more active at night and may have a better feeding response in the evening.

SUPPLEMENTATION

Food should be dusted with calcium powder. Additional supplements such as multi-vitamins can also be provided.

Maintenance

Daily feeding

Water changes and spot cleaning should also be done daily.

Full deep clean including replacing bedding should be done monthly.

Handling

Frogs can absorb chemicals and oils through their skin. Handling them should be kept to a minimum. When doing so, wash your hands and make sure to wash off any soap. Powder free gloves are the safest way to hold your animal.
