

Terrestrial Tarantula

Ease of Care: Beginner

Potential Adult Size:12-17cm (4-7")

Equipment and housing

- •Housing: Glass or plastic enclosure that is 3 x the leg spn of the animal in length and 2 x the leg span in width. Cross ventilation or plastic formed mesh lid. Wire mesh lids may cause your tarantula to get stuck.
- Heating & Lighting: steady temperature between 24 and 27c. If a heat mat is needed to achieve this, place the heat mat on the side of the enclosure as they will burrow to escape high temperatures.
- Substrate: Spider life or equivalent, coir.
- Water: Fresh water should always be available to the animal in a shallow dish. You can lightly spray the corner of the substrate each week, rotating to a new corner each week.
- Decoration and hides: these additions will give your tarantula places to hide and sleep. You can decorate the enclosure to your liking.
